Joe Palomo, Digital Security Presenter

Joe Palomo, currently an Enterprise Architect in the Information Technology department, has worked with the Sacramento Superior Court since 2002, and he has worked in the Information Technology industry for over 20 years. Joe earned an Associate's Degree in Science, Mathematics, and Engineering from Sacramento City College, a Bachelor of Science Degree in Information Technology from the University of Phoenix, and he has also earned a number of industry certifications.

Joe will present a crash course in digital security, an often overlooked subject for court reporters who deal with maintaining confidentiality on a frequent basis. This seminar will answer some questions, such as why digital security is so important for court reporters in particular, why it is important to create and use a variety of different passwords for different accounts, and what easy-to-use applications exist to facilitate a good level of digital security. This seminar is also designed to demystify and put in layman's terms some words we hear all the time but don't fully understand in the context of digital security, such as encryption and two-factor authentication.

At the end of the seminar, attendees should leave with a good grasp of basic digital security principles and will be more equipped to protect their information online in both the professional and personal spheres.
